Basic Information

- One (1) credit equals the successful completion of a course for one year;
- $\frac{1}{2}$ credit equals the successful completion of a course for one semester.
- 1 semester is made up of 2 quarters
- Eight course per semester is the required class load:
 - 4 Core / Semester
 - At least 1 Semester of P.E.
 - 1 Semester of Health
 - 4 Electives
 - Students may only enroll in one physical education (P.E.) course per semester.
- Your grades are kept on an official transcript in the Counseling Office. This is your official record of courses passed and credits earned.

Courses Needed to Graduate

All students must satisfactorily complete 22 credits for graduation (and diploma) to include the following requirements:

- ▶ English – 4.0 credits
- ▶ Science – 3.0 credits
 - ▶ (minimum of 1 credit of life and 1 credit of physical science)
- ▶ Math - 3.0 credits
- ▶ AK Studies – 0.5 credit
- ▶ World History – 1.0 credit
- ▶ U.S. History – 1.0 credit
- ▶ Government – 0.5 credit
- ▶ Electives - 4.5 credits
- ▶ Practical and/or Creative Arts - 3.0 credits (minimum of 0.5 credit practical art and 0.5 credit creative art)
- ▶ Physical Education – 1.0 credit
- ▶ Health – 0.5 credit
